Issue Resolutions for External I-Modems V 2.7.6

Resolved issues for this product are listed here.

- S13=1 now properly software resets the I-Modem when DTR drops.
- Corrected the operation of the B1 LED when a call is disconnected on B2.

V.90 Troubleshooting

- The ITU V.90 protocol, has impacted the operation of the V.8 protocol. In most instances you will
 not encounter any problems connecting to older non-U.S. Robotics equipment. However, you may
 encounter problems when connecting to equipment that implements the V.8 protocol incorrectly.
 To resolve this problem, disable V.90 by issuing the ATS58=32 command to the modem.
- In this release of the V.90 code, status messages for ATI11V.90 are intermittently incorrect on failed X2/v.90 calls. This will be corrected in future releases of this firmware.
